Existing law provides for the commitment of a person who is a danger to himself or others or is gravely disabled, as a result of a substance-related or addictive disorder or mental illness, to the La. Department of Health (LDH) when a treatment facility is otherwise unavailable; either by petition of LDH or, when LDH is not a party, upon proper stipulation of the parties.

<u>Existing law</u> provides for the commitment of a person who has a developmental disability and is either a danger to himself or others to LDH either by petition of LDH or, when LDH is not a party, upon proper stipulation of the parties.

<u>New law</u> provides that upon such commitments under <u>existing law</u>, the court shall cause reasonable notice of judgment to be given to LDH.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 11, 2019).
