Existing law allows an insurer to appoint as an agent of the insurer any insurer insurance producer who operates or intends to operate its business affairs as a partnership, corporation, or other business entity, if all persons in the business entity who are actively engaged in soliciting, negotiating, or effecting contracts of insurance or renewals hold an active producer license.

<u>New law</u> extends <u>existing law</u> to require that all persons in the business entity who actively engaged in soliciting, negotiating, or effecting contracts of insurance or renewals to register with the Department of Insurance pursuant to <u>existing law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2019.
