<u>New law</u> provides for a training, registration, and certification process for fire-resistant material applicators.

<u>New law</u> provides that a fire-resistant material applicator is a person who applies fireresistant material to a surface. <u>New law</u> requires that the fire-resistant material applicator obtain training in the application of fire-resistant material according to manufacturer recommendations. <u>New law</u> further requires fire-resistant material applicators to register with the state fire marshal's office.

<u>New law</u> requires the fire marshal to issue certificates to fire-resistant material applicators who have completed the required training and registered with the fire marshal.

<u>New law</u> establishes a fine of \$250 per violation for any person applying fire-resistant material without being certified.

<u>New law</u> provides that implementation, including appellate procedures, and enforcement be pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act.

Effective August 1, 2019.
