Existing law requires that an applicant under the age of 17 maintain a Class "E" learner's license for 180 days while remaining accident free, unless the licensee is not at fault, and receive no convictions for moving violations or violations of seat belt or curfew laws of this state or any law pertaining to drugs or alcohol use.

New law modifies existing law by requiring a parent or legal guardian of the applicant to provide a signed statement to the department attesting to the fact that the applicant has followed all of the requirements in existing law.

Effective Aug. 1, 2019.
