Leopold

Existing law requires a permit for a person to take oysters for commercial purposes from the public natural reefs or oyster seed grounds or reservations. Provides that the cost of the annual permit for use of a single scraper is \$250 for a resident and \$1,000 for a nonresident. The cost of the permit for use of a double scraper is \$500 for a resident and \$2,000 for a nonresident.

<u>New law</u> permits the use of tongs or harvesting by hand under the cost of a permit for use of a single scraper. Further provides that the permit granted for a double scraper also permits the use of any legal means of harvest.
