10	accompanying affidavit is a ground for the denial, withholding, or suspension
11	of a permit in the manner provided in this Chapter, and may also include the
12	filing of criminal charges pursuant to R.S. 14:133.

<u>Present law</u> provides that any misstatement or suppression of fact in an application or accompanying affidavit is a ground for the denial, withholding or suspension of an alcoholic beverage permit in the manner provided in <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further provides that any misstatement or suppression of fact may also result in the filing of criminal charges of filing false public records against the person completing the application.

Effective August 1, 2020.
