Zeringue

Appropriates supplemental funding and provides for means of financing substitutions and other budgetary adjustments for Fiscal Year 2019-2020. Provides for net increases (decreases) as follows: State General Fund (Direct) by \$0; Interagency Transfers by \$5,860,216; Fees & Self-generated Revenues by \$25,662,511; Statutory Dedications by \$20,975,000; and Federal Funds by \$127,099,645.

Additionally appropriates \$53,450,952 of State General Fund (Direct) of nonrecurring revenue out of the surplus from Fiscal Year 2018-19 for the Unfunded Accrued Liability in state retirement systems.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
