Abstract: Provides for the authorization of civilian traffic control officers or entities to investigate certain traffic accidents in municipalities with populations greater than 300,000.

<u>Present law</u> requires state police or the sheriff's office to investigate all accidents that occur within their parish or municipality.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the superintendent of police in municipalities greater than 300,000 to authorize a civilian traffic control officer or entity to investigate traffic accidents.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the civilian traffic control officer or entity from issuing traffic citations and from investigating any of the following accidents which shall be reported to the municipality's police department:

- (1) An accident that results in death or injury to any person.
- (2) An accident that involves a driver who refuses to or cannot provide a driver's license, proof of insurance, or vehicle registration.
- (3) An accident involving a driver who is suspected of being under the influence of alcohol, narcotics, or other controlled substances.
