BY SENATOR HENSGENS

MOTOR VEHICLES. Provides eligibility for retired law officer's special license plates to law officers who retire due to injures sustained in the line of duty regardless of the length of employment. (8/1/2020)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 47:463.24(D), relative to special motor vehicle license plates for
3 retired law officers; to provide with respect to the criteria for eligibility for a retired
4 law officer's special license plate; to add eligibility for law officers injured in the line
5 of duty who retired for medical reasons due to permanent injuries sustained in the
6 line of duty regardless of length of employment to persons eligible for a retired law
7 officer's special license plate; and to provide for related matters.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 47:463.24(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

10 §463.24. Special license plates for retired law officers

11 * * *

12 D. Any person who was employed as a law officer for twelve years or more,
13 was not discharged for misconduct related to employment, and has not been
14 convicted of any felony, or any person who was employed as a law officer and
15 retired for medical reasons due to permanent injuries sustained in the line of
16 duty regardless of length of employment, shall be eligible for a special license
17 plate under the provisions of this Section and renewal of such special license plate,
