<u>Present law</u> provides that when law enforcement officers determine that an operator of a vehicle has a suspended or revoked drivers license at the time of a stop and the vehicle is registered to the operator, the officer shall remove the license plate and issue a form to be promulgated by the department.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further provides that the officer can issue an electronic form similar to the form promulgated by the department.

<u>Present law</u> provides that when an operator of a motor vehicle fails to produce identification of motor vehicle liability insurance then the vehicle shall be impounded and the operator shall be issued a notice of noncompliance on a form to be provided by the department.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further allows the notice of noncompliance to be issued through an electronic form.
