JUVENILE PROCEDURE: Provides relative to juvenile court-ordered physical and mental care and exam fees

2	To amend and reenact Children's Code Article 868(B) and to repeal Children's Code Articles
3	774(B) and 888(C), relative to certain juvenile court-ordered fees; to eliminate court-
4	ordered physical and mental care and exam fees and costs; and to provide for related
5	matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. Children's Code Article 868(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read
8	as follows:
9	Art. 868. Medical treatment of children; costs
10	* * *
11	B. If the parent fails to provide such care, the court may, after due notice to
12	the parent, order the care and order the parent to pay all or part of the expense.
13	Section 2. Children's Code Articles 774(B) and 888(C) are hereby repealed in their
14	entirety.

Abstract: Eliminates costs for juvenile court-ordered child physical and mental exams.

<u>Present law</u> provides that caretakers and parents shall contribute to the cost of any courtordered examination or evaluation. <u>Proposed law</u> eliminates costs to parents and caretakers for court-ordered examinations or evaluations of the child.
