Abstract: Provides that delictual actions are subject to a two-year prescriptive period and limits recovery of medical or healthcare expenses incurred to the amount actually paid or incurred by or on behalf of the claimant.

<u>Present law</u> provides, with certain exceptions, a one-year prescriptive period for delictual actions which commences from the day the injury or damage is sustained.

<u>Present law</u> provides a two-year prescriptive period for delictual actions arising from crimes of violence and provides a three-year prescriptive period for delictual actions arising out of any act of sexual assault.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals the one-year prescriptive period, provides that delictual actions are subject to a two-year prescriptive period, and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> limits recovery of medical or healthcare expenses incurred to the amount actually paid or incurred by or on behalf of the claimant.
