Abstract: Creates a \$500,000 limitation for general damages in civil suits.

<u>Present law</u> provides that every act of a person that causes damages obliges that person who is at fault to repair it.

<u>Present law</u> provides that damages may include loss of consortium, service, and society, but does not include such costs as future medical treatment.

<u>Proposed law provides for a \$500,000 limitation for general damages, excluding special or economic damages, in civil suits.</u>

Proposed law defines "general damages."
