ELDERLY OR NO IMPACT See Note Requires reports of elderly exploitation or extortion to be reported to local law enforcement agencies. (8/1/20)

<u>Present law</u> requires the appropriate adult protection agency to notify the chief law enforcement agency of the parish in which the incident is alleged to have occurred when the agency receives a report of sexual or physical abuse, whether directly or by referral. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but adds exploitation and extortion to the types of incidents to be reported.
