

1 WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted by Article III, Section 20 of the
2 Constitution of Louisiana, it is necessary for the Legislature of Louisiana to suspend the
3 effects of all legal deadlines, including liberative prescription, preemptive periods, and filing
4 deadlines applicable to legal proceedings in all courts, administrative agencies, and boards.

5 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby suspends
6 the provisions of all laws which apply to all legal deadlines, including liberative prescription,
7 preemptive periods, and filing deadlines applicable to legal proceedings in all courts,
8 administrative agencies, and boards, including but not limited to such deadlines set forth by
9 law within all of the following:

10 (1) Louisiana Civil Code.

11 (2) Louisiana Code of Civil Procedure.

12 (3) Title 9 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Civil Code Ancillaries.

13 (4) Title 13 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Courts and Judicial
14 Procedure.

15 (5) Chapter 11 of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Election
16 Campaign Finance.

17 (6) Chapter 10 of Title 23 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Workers'
18 Compensation.

19 (7) Part IV of Subchapter E of Chapter 5-D of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised
20 Statutes of 1950, Malpractice Liability for State Services.

21 (8) Part I of Subchapter E of Chapter 5-D of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised
22 Statutes of 1950, Medical Malpractice.

23 (9) Chapter 13 of Title 49 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Administrative
24 Procedure.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this suspension shall become effective upon
26 adoption of this Resolution and shall extend through the sixtieth day after final adjournment
27 of the 2021 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.
