FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS OR NO IMPACT See Note Provides for a special identification card for persons over the age of 60. (8/1/20)

<u>Present law</u> provides that persons age 60 years or older may obtain an identification card without charge; and these identification cards shall not expire. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that persons age 60 years or older may obtain an identification card that complies with the standards of Real ID without charge. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that Real ID cards expire every 6 years. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that the Department of Public Safety and Correction, Public Safety Services, Office of Motor Vehicles can issue a Real ID card to person age 60 years or older with an expiration of less than 6 years under legal presence circumstances or other special restrictions. <u>Proposed law</u> effective August 1, 2020.

The department reports that it can issue Real ID cards for persons 60 years or older under this measure utilizing existing personnel and budgetary resources.
