Proposed law amends criminal penalties for the crime unlawful use of an unmanned aircraft system.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in Local Funds expenditures to local governing authorities if a person is convicted of the crime of unlawful use of an unmanned aircraft system. The maximum imprisonment term is two years (<u>present law</u> is six months). The number of individuals that may be convicted of this crime is indeterminable.

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in SGF expenditures to the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and - Corrections Services if a person is convicted for a second or subsequent offense of the crime unlawful use of an unmanned aircraft system. The maximum imprisonment term is five years (<u>present law</u> is one year) with or without hard labor. The number of individuals that may be convicted of this crime is indeterminable.

SGF expenditures will increase by \$67.44 per offender per day if an offender is housed in a state facility or \$26.39 for a state offender housed in a local facility. An offender sentenced to the custody of the DPSC - CS for one year would increase SGF expenditures by \$24,615.60 (\$67.44 per day x 365 days) if housed in a state facility and \$9,632.35 (\$26.39 per day x 365 days) if housed in a local facility. Approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in state facilities and approximately 50% are housed in local facilities.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in Local Funds revenues as a result of potential fines for the crime unlawful use of an unmanned aircraft system. The maximum fine for this crime is \$5,000 (present law is \$500).

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in Local Funds revenues as a result of potential fines for the crime unlawful use of an unmanned aircraft system. The maximum fine for a second or subsequent offense for this crime is \$20,000 (present law is \$2,000).

The potential revenue will accrue to local governing authorities.

The number of individuals that may be convicted of this crime is indeterminable.
