Abstract: Establishes a statewide dual enrollment program.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "dual enrollment" and what constitutes a dual enrollment course.

<u>Present law</u> establishes the Higher Education Initiatives Fund and provides that money in the fund shall be used for higher education purposes. <u>Proposed law</u> creates a dual enrollment grant to be used to implement dual enrollment programs and to provide for equitable access and participation. <u>Proposed law</u> requires that a portion of the money in the Higher Education Initiatives Fund be used for the grant.

<u>Present law</u> established the Dual Enrollment Task Force and required local public school boards to develop agreements with colleges and universities for articulation and transfer of credit. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u>.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
