Abstract: Expands criteria for a State Seal of Biliteracy to be affixed on the diploma or transcript of a high school graduate.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a State Seal of Biliteracy to be affixed to the high school diploma or transcript of a graduate who is proficient in multiple languages. <u>Proposed law</u> retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides that to qualify for such a seal, a student must complete certain graduation requirements, demonstrate proficiency at the intermediate-high level or above in at least one language other than English, and attain certain ACT subscores. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and allows, in lieu of certain ACT subscores, equivalent concordant scores on certain parts of the SAT.

Proposed law is retroactive to Aug. 1, 2014.
