- On page 1, line 4, after "emergency;" insert "to provide certain terms, conditions, and
- 6 requirements;"

# 7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

- 8 On page 1, delete line 6, and insert, "Section 1. R.S. 29:735.3.1(A) is hereby amended and
- 9 reenacted and R.S. 29:735.3.2 is"

#### 10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

- On page 1, line 11, after "political subdivisions" delete the remainder of the line and delete
- 12 line 12, and insert the following:
- 13 ", including but not limited to the manufacturing, distribution, donation, or use
- of hand sanitizers, disinfecting productions, protective clothing, helmets, gloves, face
- shields, goggles, face masks, respirators, or other equipment designed in accordance
- with government standards to protect the wearer from injury or the spread of infection
- or illness, shall not be liable to the recipient thereof"

#### 18 AMENDMENT NO. 5

- 19 On page 2, between lines 5 and 6, insert the following:
- 20 "Section 2. Due to the imminent threat posed by COVID-19 as provided in
- 21 Proclamation Number 25 JBE 2020 and any subsequent proclamation, declaring the
- 22 existence of a statewide public health emergency, Section 1 of this Act shall be retroactive
- 23 to March 11, 2020."
