Any board or commission that issues licenses to engage in occupations or professions shall waive the examination fee if remitted to the board or commission 8 9 and initial license fee upon request and upon the showing of good cause by an 10 applicant. For purposes of this Section, good cause shall be found if the applicant earns less than two hundred percent of the current federal poverty guidelines as 11 established by the federal office of management and budget or the applicant receives 12 13 public assistance, including but not limited to assistance through the following 14 programs:
 - (1) Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program.
 - (2) Temporary assistance for needy families.
 - (3) Medicaid.
 - (4) Disability insurance.

- B. An examination fee shall not be waived pursuant to Subsection A of this
 Section if it is remitted to an entity other than the board or commission.
- 22 <u>C. Each board and commission shall publish information on the board or commission's website about the ability of an application to request the waiver of an initial license fee if the applicant meets the criteria provided in Subsection A."</u>
