2 3	On page 1, line 5, after "marijuana;" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 6 and 7 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
4 5 6	"to provide for a limit on the retail price of medical marijuana; to require pharmacies that dispense medical marijuana to offer delivery service to patients; to provide for effectiveness; and to provide for related matters."

8 9	On page 1, after line 16, delete the remainder of the page and delete page 2 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
10 11 12 13 14 15	"G.(1) The Louisiana Board of Pharmacy shall develop an annual, nontransferable specialty license for a pharmacy to dispense recommended marijuana for therapeutic use and shall limit the number of such licenses granted in the state to no more than ten licensees. The Louisiana Board of Pharmacy shall develop rules and regulations regarding the geographical locations of dispensing pharmacies in Louisiana.
16 17 18 19 20	(2) The board shall prohibit each holder of a specialty license developed in accordance with this Subsection from selling recommended marijuana for therapeutic use at a retail price that is greater than two hundred percent of the wholesale price that it paid for the product. The board shall provide in rule for penalties for violations of the prohibition provided in this Paragraph.
21	Section 2. R.S. 40:1046(G) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

The Louisiana Board of Pharmacy shall develop rules and regulations regarding the geographical locations of dispensing pharmacies in Louisiana.
35 36 37 38	(2) Each holder of a specialty license developed in accordance with this Subsection shall offer delivery service to patients throughout the geographic region in which it is located in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of the board.

(3) The board shall prohibit each holder of a specialty license developed in

accordance with this Subsection from selling recommended marijuana for

4 Section 3. Section 1 of this Act shall become effective August 1, 2020.

Notwithstanding Section 3 of this Act, Section 2 of this Act shall take effect and become operative, and shall supersede the provisions of Section 1 of this Act, if and when the Act which originated as House Bill No. 792 of this 2020 Regular Session of the Legislature is enacted and becomes effective."
