Present law provides that women employed by the state shall be entitled to the same compensation as men employed by the state. Proposed law extends present law to provide that pay equality shall also apply to women employed by an employer that has fifteen or more employees within the state.

To the extent the proposed legislation increases the number of pay inequality lawsuits filed in district courts, an indeterminable increase in court costs associated with judicial workload, time and attendance (presence of judges, clerks, bailiffs, counsel, etc.) may result.
