Appropriates supplemental funding and provides for means of financing substitutions and other budgetary adjustments for Fiscal Year 2019-2020. Provides for net increases (decreases) as follows: State General Fund (Direct) by (\$133,127,138); Interagency Transfers by \$474,317,745; Fees & Self-generated Revenues by (\$23,703,910); Statutory Dedications by (\$290,977,277); and Federal Funds by \$1,011,660,168.

Additionally appropriates \$53,450,952 of State General Fund (Direct) of nonrecurring revenue out of the surplus from Fiscal Year 2018-19 for the Unfunded Accrued Liability in state retirement systems.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
