33 "Section 2. R.S. 13:2151.4(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
34 §2151.4. Second City Court; judge; clerk; constable; jurisdiction

36 D. The civil jurisdiction is concurrent with the district court in cases where
37 the amount in dispute, as defined in Code of Civil Procedure Article 4841(B), or the
38 value of the property involved, does not exceed ~~twenty-five~~ fifty thousand dollars.
