SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

- 1. Removes reference to per diem and mileage reimbursements based on the amount jurors receive in federal court.
- 2. Specifically sets the juror rate in civil cases to \$50/day and removes any reimbursement for mileage.

<u>Present law</u> provides that jurors in civil cases receive \$25/day and a mileage reimbursement of 16 cents per mile.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the juror in a civil case receive \$50/day and removes the 16 cents per mile mileage reimbursement.

Effective January 1, 2021.
