COMMENDATIONS. Commends Antavion Jacarri Moore for being named the 2020 Louisiana High School Student of the Year.

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend Antavion Jacarri Moore upon being named the 2020 Louisiana High School
3 Student of the Year by the Department of Education.

4 WHEREAS, Antavion Moore graduated from Ringgold High School in Bienville
5 Parish, having earned an associate's degree and certificate in general studies; and

6 WHEREAS, Antavion Moore has excelled in academia, dual enrollment, Advanced
7 Placement, and his career and technical course work, and he is also a talented musician; and

8 WHEREAS, entering college full-time, Antavion plans to continue his studies with
9 a major in biomedical engineering, with an ultimate goal of becoming an orthopedic
10 surgeon; and

11 WHEREAS, Antavion Moore represented Louisiana at the 2019 National 4-H
12 Conference, where he presented ideas on the future of agricultural leadership to the
13 Department of Agriculture; and

14 WHEREAS, in his local community, Antavion Moore attends the mayor's monthly
15 meetings and updates citizens on new ordinances and events, and represents to the city
16 leadership the viewpoint of the community's youth; and

17 WHEREAS, at his young age, Antavion Moore has written a draft of a congressional
18 bill on mandatory computer science curriculum in schools, which he presented at a gathering

1 noted as "Citizenship Washington Focus"; and

2 WHEREAS, Citizenship Washington Focus is 4-H's premier leadership and
3 citizenship program for high school students, and it is an opportunity for 4-H members to
4 learn how to be citizen leaders and make a difference in their communities while giving the
5 students a behind-the-scenes look at the nation's capital and a chance to meet members of
6 Congress and develop communication, leadership, and citizenship skills through hands-on
7 learning and group activities; Antavion Moore then put into practice these skills at the
8 mayor's monthly meetings; and

9 WHEREAS, the annual competition within the state Department of Education is open
10 to all public and nonpublic schools which may each nominate one candidate from their
11 student body to be candidates for the student of the year honor; and

12 WHEREAS, once students from each school are chosen, they compete with their
13 peers in their geographic region on the basis of academic achievement, leadership skills,
14 character, and for the first time this academic year, their career and technical education
15 achievements; and

16 WHEREAS, Antavion Jacarri Moore has clearly met and exceeded the criteria of the
17 Louisiana Department of Education with his outstanding academic achievements and his
18 civic involvement on both the national and community level; he stands as an outstanding
19 example of a student taking advantage of all opportunities offered and making the most of
20 those opportunities to learn and grow as much as possible during one's high school years.

21 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
22 does hereby commend Antavion Jacarri Moore upon being named the 2020 Louisiana High
23 School Student of the Year by the Department of Education.
