## ACT 156 (HB 653) 2020 Regular Session

Existing law provides a mechanism for businesses to transfer abandoned property to the state treasurer.

<u>Prior law</u> (R.S. 9:159) required holders of certain categories of abandoned property to report the abandoned property to the state treasurer when the property had a value of \$50 or more. <u>New law</u> lowers this to a value of \$10 or more.

<u>Prior law</u> (R.S. 9:161) required the treasurer, as administrator of unclaimed property, to advertise the name and address or location of an owner of unclaimed property having a total value greater than \$50. <u>New law</u> raises the threshold <u>from</u> \$50 to \$100.

Effective Aug. 1, 2020.
