Existing law authorizes the Louisiana Tourism Promotion District to levy and collect a sales and use tax at a rate not to exceed .03% for the purpose of assisting the state in promoting tourism.

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes the transfer of a portion of the proceeds of the tax to the Dept. of Culture, Recreation and Tourism (Dept.) to promote tourism. <u>Existing law</u> further provides that the amount of funds used by the Dept. for the purpose of in-state media advertisements shall not exceed 10% of all funds used for the purchase of media advertisement.

<u>New law</u> suspends provisions of <u>existing law</u> relative to the maximum amount of funds that may be used by the Dept. for the purchase of in-state media advertisement until 60 days after final adjournment of the 2021 R.S.
