CONGRESS: Memorializes the United States Senate to confirm the nomination of Judge Amy Coney Barrett to the United States Supreme Court

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2	To memorialize the United States Senate to take such actions as are necessary to confirm
3	President Donald Trump's nomination of Judge Amy Coney Barrett to the United
4	States Supreme Court to fill the seat of the late Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg.
5	WHEREAS, the United States of America was founded on the precepts of freedom,
6	liberty, justice, and diversity; and
7	WHEREAS, a primary mission of the United States Senate is to ensure that the
8	judiciary maintains integrity; and
9	WHEREAS, Judge Amy Coney Barrett has served on the United States Court of
10	Appeals for the Seventh Circuit since 2017; and
11	WHEREAS, Amy Coney Barrett was born in New Orleans, Louisiana, and grew up
12	in Metairie, Louisiana; after graduating from St. Mary's Dominican High School in 1990,
13	she attended Rhodes College and graduated magna cum laude in 1994 with a bachelor of arts
14	degree in English literature; she then studied law at Notre Dame Law School, graduating
15	first in her class summa cum laude in 1997 with a juris doctorate degree and serving as
16	executive editor of the Notre Dame Law Review; and
17	WHEREAS, upon completion of her law school studies, Amy Coney Barrett served
18	as judicial law clerk for Judge Laurence Silberman of the United States Court of Appeals for
19	the District of Columbia Circuit from 1997 to 1998 and Justice Antonin Scalia of the United
20	States Supreme Court from 1998 to 1999; and

1 WHEREAS, Judge Amy Coney Barrett has worked in both private trial and appellate 2 litigation in Washington, D.C.; during this time, she also worked for more than fifteen years 3 in academia, including at her alma mater, Notre Dame Law School, and has been published 4 in several prominent journals including the Columbia Law Review, Virginia Law Review, 5 and Texas Law Review; and 6 WHEREAS, Judge Amy Coney Barrett has earned accolades and bipartisan praise for her character and work ethic and has demonstrated a steadfast dedication to upholding 7 8 the United States Constitution as written and not legislating from the bench; her excellent 9 judicial record shows she will protect the rights of Americans and defend the rule of law. 10 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby 11 memorialize the United States Senate to take such actions as are necessary to confirm the 12 nomination of Judge Amy Coney Barrett to the United States Supreme Court. 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the 14 presiding officers of the Senate and to the Honorable Bill Cassidy and the Honorable John 15 Kennedy.
