## 2 To urge and request the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to meet to 3 discuss possible adjustments to the Minimum Foundation Program formula to ensure 4 adequate funding for school systems affected by the displacement of students due to 5 Hurricane Laura, to take into account the financial needs of systems that have lost 6 students and systems that have gained students due to the hurricane, and, if 7 adjustments are necessary, to adopt a revised formula and submit it to the legislature 8 while the legislature is convened for the 2020 Second Extraordinary Session and has 9 the opportunity to consider the revised formula for approval. 10 WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section 13(B) of the Constitution of Louisiana requires the 11 State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to develop and adopt annually 12 a formula which shall be used to determine the cost of a minimum foundation program 13 (MFP) of education in all public elementary and secondary schools as well as to allocate 14 equitably the funds to parish and city school systems; and 15 WHEREAS, the constitution requires the legislature to fully fund the current cost to 16 the state of the MFP as determined by applying the legislatively approved formula; and 17 WHEREAS, Hurricane Laura, which made landfall in August of 2020, drastically 18 disrupted elementary and secondary education services in multiple parishes; and 19 WHEREAS, unprecedented and widespread damage to homes and school facilities 20 has resulted in the closure of schools and the displacement of thousands of families; and

WHEREAS, it is critical that adequate funding be provided both to parishes experiencing decreased enrollment due to the displacement of students and those whose enrollment has increased due to the intake of displaced students.
