Owen is among the more than nine hundred American World 5 War I casualties with ties to Louisiana who are recorded in the Rolling Thunder National 6 Riders' archive; the Rolling Thunder National Riders work to document the generations of 7 military veterans who lost their lives in service to their country from World War I through 8 the Vietnam War; and 9 WHEREAS, Charley enlisted in the United States Army during World War I and 10 held the rank of Private; he developed an illness or serious disease which resulted in his 11 death on October 13, 1918; and 12 WHEREAS, Private Owen and all other Louisianians who lost their lives defending 13 our country are indubitably American heroes; the service and sacrifice of all Louisiana 14 military veterans is worthy of the highest recognition and shall never be forgotten. 15 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the 16 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby posthumously commend U.S. Army Private Charley 17 F.
