- 9 "Section 1. R.S. 39:100.45(A) and 100.48(B) are hereby amended and 10 reenacted to read as follows:
- 11 §100.45. State Coronavirus Relief Fund 12 A. There is hereby created and established in the state treasury, as a special fund, the State Coronavirus Relief Fund, hereinafter the "relief fund". On December 13 1, 2020, the treasurer is authorized and directed to transfer any unobligated monies 14 15 in the Coronavirus Local Recovery Allocation Fund and the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Fund to the relief fund to. Any monies in the relief fund may be used by 16 the state, subject to appropriation if the legislature is in session, or the Joint 17 18 Legislative Committee on the Budget, if the legislature is not in session, for the 19 purposes of supplementing the state's account in the unemployment trust fund 20 in the United States Treasury or providing monies to local government units, 21 eligible businesses, or the state in accordance with the provisions of this Subpart and 22 the CARES Act. 23 \* 24 §100.48. Critical Infrastructure Workers Hazard Pay Rebate Fund

B. The monies in the rebate fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the rebate fund shall be deposited in and credited to the rebate fund. If applicable under federal guidelines, unexpended and unencumbered monies in the rebate fund shall remain in the rebate fund. The treasurer shall transfer any unobligated balance in the fund on December 1, 2020, to the State Coronavirus Relief Fund. \* \* \* \*
