- "Section 1. R.S. 17:7(34) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
- 15 §7. Duties, functions, and responsibilities of board

In addition to the authorities granted by R.S. 17:6 and any powers, duties, and responsibilities vested by any other applicable laws, the board shall:

(34) The board shall study the feasibility and advisability of establishing an appeals process for students denied transfer to a higher-performing school pursuant to R.S. 17:4035.1. The study shall include an analysis of the board's constitutional authority to make decisions regarding local school enrollment capacity and the costs of such student transfers to both the sending and receiving school systems. The board shall submit a written report of its findings and recommendations to the Senate Committee on Finance, the House Committee on Appropriations, the Senate Committee on Education, and the House Committee on Education not later than
