11	documentation and strict adherence to a multitude of legal formalities; and
12	WHEREAS, while remaining mindful of the need to guard against fraud, waste, and
13	abuse, the Louisiana House of Representatives recognizes that aid programs in the future
14	should, to the extent possible, be made easier so that suffering business owners can access
15	necessary funding.
