Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

ENVIRONMENT/AIR: Provides relative to public notices for minor source facilities

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2	To amend the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality rule LAC
3	33:III.531(A)(2)(introductory paragraph), which provides for public notice by the
4	permitting authority for certain major source facilities; to provide for public notice
5	requirements by the permitting authority for certain minor source facilities; to direct
6	the office of the state register to print the amendments in the Louisiana
7	Administrative Code; and to provide for related matters.
8	WHEREAS, the purity of the air in the environment is a matter of vital concern to
9	the welfare of the people of the state; and
10	WHEREAS, it is necessary in this day and age to promote an environment free from
11	pollution that can be harmful to the health and welfare of the citizens of the state; and
12	WHEREAS, pollution in the environment can result from the existence,
13	development, and expansion of commerce, industry, and other enterprises and can endanger
14	the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of this state; and
15	WHEREAS, recent data indicate that more than eighty-five million Americans, or
16	about one-third of our nation's population, continue to breathe unhealthy air as industrial and
17	mobile sources release millions of tons of pollutants into the atmosphere annually; and
18	WHEREAS, air pollution comes not only from large industrial sources, such as
19	chemical plants and utilities, but also from smaller sources such as small industrial facilities,
20	dry cleaners, and service stations; and

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1	WHEREAS, stationary sources of air pollution, such as electric utilities, oil
2	refineries, factories, and other industrial and commercial facilities account for nearly half
3	of the nation's air pollution; and
4	WHEREAS, toxic air pollutants from stationary sources such as arsenic, cyanide,
5	chloroform, and formaldehyde constitute the largest single category of chemical releases into
6	the environment, approaching over two billion pounds annually; and
7	WHEREAS, there are increasing quantities of such air contaminants being emitted
8	every day representing the greatest risk to human health; and
9	WHEREAS, these environmental contaminants can be especially harmful to citizens
10	living near industrial refineries and chemical plants; and
11	WHEREAS, as the number of unanticipated emergency emissions by individual
12	facilities grows, so does the potential magnitude of human exposure to dangerous substances
13	and the severity of acute adverse effects to human health associated with such substances;
14	and
15	WHEREAS, in order to protect human health and the environment, the Department
16	of Environmental Quality (DEQ) should make every effort to keep the public informed of
17	environmental pollution by providing public notice; and
18	WHEREAS, requiring DEQ to provide public notice for permit modifications and
19	expansions for certain minor source facilities, as well as major source facilities, will greatly
20	benefit members of the public by putting them on notice, giving them a chance to attend
21	public meetings, and providing an opportunity for public comment on potential
22	modifications to source emitting facilities that may impact their health and wellbeing.
23	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of Louisiana that LAC
24	33:III.531(A)(2)(introductory paragraph) is hereby amended to read as follows:
25	§531. Public Notice and Affected State Notice
26	A.

For applications pertaining to a Part 70 source, public Public notice shall 2 be published by the permitting authority prior to the issuance of any permit which 3 is: 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the 6 office of the state register. 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the office of the state register is hereby directed 8 to have the amendments to LAC 33:III.531(A)(2)(introductory paragraph) printed and 9 incorporated into the Louisiana Administrative Code.

Abstract: Requires the Dept. of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to provide public notice for any permit or permit modification for all source facilities not otherwise exempt.

<u>Present LAC</u> (33:III.531) provides for requirements for public notice to be provided by the permitting authority (DEQ) for permitting stationary source facilities.

<u>Present LAC</u> (33:III.531(A)(2)(introductory paragraph)) provides for requirements for public notice to be provided by the permitting authority (DEQ) for permit applications and modifications for Part 70 source facilities.

<u>Proposed LAC</u> (33:III.531(A)(2)(introductory paragraph)) changes requirement for public notice to be provided by the permitting authority for permit applications and modifications <u>from</u> applying strictly to Part 70 source facilities <u>to</u> including all source facilities not otherwise exempt.

Directs the La. Register to print the amendment to LAC 33:III.531(A)(2)(introductory paragraph) in the La. Administrative Code.
