On page 4, line 2, after "approve" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 3 through
9 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

4 "<u>the application of or the participation in the insurance regulatory sandbox</u> 5 program by any person to whom any of the following applies:

(1) The conviction or nolo contendere plea to any felony, participation in a pretrial diversion program pursuant to a felony charge, suspension and deferral of sentence and probation pursuant to Code of Criminal Procedure Article 893, or conviction of any misdemeanor involving breach of trust, moral turpitude, or public corruption.

11(2) The conviction of a felony involving dishonesty or breach of trust12pursuant to 18 U.S.C. 1033 and 1034, without written consent from the13commissioner pursuant to 18 U.S.C. 1033, or any successor statute regulating14crimes by or affecting persons engaged in the business of insurance whose15activities affect interstate commerce.

16(3) If the applicant or participant is a business entity, refusal to remove17or discharge any person who has been convicted of or pleaded nolo contendere18to any felony, participated in a pretrial diversion program pursuant to a felony19charge, suspension and deferral of sentence, and probation pursuant to Code20of Criminal Procedure Article 893, or been convicted of any misdemeanor21involving breach of trust, moral turpitude, or public corruption."
