- A. It shall not be necessary to open judicially the small succession of a person domiciled in Louisiana who died intestate or testate as provided
- by Article 3421(B) or probate of the testament of the deceased would have
 the same effect as if the deceased had died intestate or a person domiciled
 outside of Louisiana who died intestate or whose testament has been
- probated by court order of another state, and whose sole heirs are the following:
- 18 (1) His descendants.
- 19 (2) His ascendants.
- 20 (3) His brothers or sisters, or descendants thereof.
- 21 (4) His surviving spouse.
- 22 (5) His legatees under a testament probated by court order of another
- 23 state."
