 10 A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the
 - A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the "American Rescue Plan Act Small Business and Nonprofit Youth Employment Fund," hereinafter referred to as the "Employment Fund" to be administered as provided in this Section.
 - B. The Employment Fund is designed to provide funding from a portion of the federal monies allocated to Louisiana pursuant to the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 for the purpose of providing assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits from the negative economic impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency.
 - C. The treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer one hundred million dollars from the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund into the Employment Fund. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the fund shall be deposited in and credited to the fund. To the extent allowed by applicable federal law and guidance, unexpended and unencumbered monies in the Employment Fund at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in the Employment Fund. Monies in the Employment Fund shall be used solely as provided in this Section.
 - D. For purposes of this Section the following terms shall have the following meanings:
 - (1) "Department" means the Louisiana Department of Revenue.
 - (2) "Eligible nonprofit" means a nonprofit corporation or single member limited liability company wholly owned by a nonprofit corporation that meets all of the following criteria:
 - (a) Was domiciled in Louisiana as of March 1, 2020.
 - (b) Is in good standing with the secretary of state, if applicable.
 - (c) Suffered an interruption of operations caused by forced or voluntary closures or restricted operations due to social distancing measures, decreased customer demand, cleaning or disinfection expenses, or providing personal protective equipment.
 - (d) Is in good standing with the Internal Revenue Service and has filed the Form 990 for tax year 2019 or 2020, if applicable.
 - (e) Filed Louisiana tax returns for tax year 2019 or 2020, if applicable.

29 20	(4) "Eligible youth" means an individual who meets all of the following
30	<u>criteria:</u>
31	(a) Has attained the age of sixteen but not yet attained the age of twenty-four.
32	(b) Was unemployed prior to being hired by a business that will apply for a
33	credit pursuant to the provisions of this Section.
34	(c) Will be working in a full-time or part-time position that pays wages that
35	are equivalent to the wages paid for similar jobs, with adjustments for experience and
36	training.
37	(d) Meets at least one of the following criteria:
38	(i) Is at least eighteen years old, is no longer in school, and does not have a
39	high school diploma or high school equivalency diploma or a HiSET or GED
40	credential,
41	(ii) Is a member of a family that is receiving assistance from the Family
42	Independence Temporary Assistance Program.
43	(iii) Is a member of a family that is receiving benefits through the
44	Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program.
45	(iv) Is a member of a family that is receiving assistance from the Kinship
46	Care Subsidy Program.
47	(v) Is a member of a family that is receiving assistance or benefits under the
48	Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program.
49	(vi) Has served time in jail or prison or is on probation or parole.
50	(vii) Is pregnant or is a parent.

52	(ix) Is currently or was in foster care, extended foster care, or the custody of

55	(xi) Is the child of a parent who is currently incarcerated or was released
56	from incarceration within the past two years.
57	(xii) Lives in public housing or receives housing assistance such as a Section

8	E. An eligible small business or eligible nonprofit that hires an eligible youth
9	on or after July 1, 2021 shall be eligible for a grant pursuant to the provisions of this
10	Section. Notwithstanding any provision of this Section to the contrary, no grant shall
11	be awarded to the eligible business or eligible nonprofit unless the eligible youth has
12	worked at least three consecutive months in a full-time or part-time position at the
13	business or nonprofit.
14	F.(1) The grants awarded pursuant to the provisions of this Section shall be
15	equal to:
16	(a) \$2,500 for each eligible youth who works at least three consecutive
17	months in a full-time position.
18	(b) \$1,250 for each eligible youth who works at least three consecutive
19	months in a part-time position.
20	(2) In no event shall an eligible business or an eligible nonprofit received
21	awards pursuant to the provisions of this Section in the aggregate in excess of
22	twenty-five thousand dollars.

25	H. The hiring business or nonprofit shall not terminate an employee or

29	eligible youth meets eligibility criteria as required by the secretary.
