<u>Present law</u> requires an absentee by mail ballot to be marked as provided in <u>present law</u> and returned to the registrar by the United States Postal Service, a commercial courier, or hand-delivery.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains the delivery methods in <u>present law</u> and requires a hand-delivered absentee by mail ballot to be returned to an employee of the registrar at the registrar's principal office, branch office, early voting location during the period for early voting, or mobile registration unit.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
