Boudreaux

<u>Present law</u> provides for a moratorium on additional beds for nursing facilities which expires on July 1, 2022. Proposed law extends the moratorium until July 1, 2027.

<u>Present law</u> provides an exemption to the moratorium for the replacement of existing facilities if there is no increase in existing nursing home beds at the replacement facility. <u>Proposed law</u> expands the exemption to no increase within the same service area.

<u>Present law</u> provides that any nursing home bed in alternate health care use as of August 15, 2006, may be voluntarily taken out of alternate use and re-licensed as a nursing home bed, unless those beds are otherwise deemed expired, revoked, or surrendered. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u>. Effective August 1, 2021.
