- 9 On page 2, between lines 4 and 5, insert the following:
- "(5) Cutting, clearing, removing, or diverting for sale or use of any cypress trees for integrated coastal protection as defined in R.S. 49:214.2(11) or a project listed in the comprehensive master coastal protection plan as defined in R.S. 49:214.2(12).
- (6) Cutting, clearing, removing, or diverting for sale or use of any cypress trees for any levee or drainage project by the departments, agencies, boards, or commissions of the state of Louisiana and their political subdivisions, including but not limited to a levee district or levee and drainage district as identified in Chapter 4 of Title 38 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, parishes or municipalities,
- 19 and the United States."
- 20 AMENDMENT NO. 5
- 21 On page 2, between lines 21 and 22, insert the following:
- "Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
- 23 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
- by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
- vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 26 effective on the day following such approval."
