Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 39:100.44, the treasurer shall utilize the resources of the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program to administer 22 23 the Louisiana Loggers Relief Program and the Louisiana Save Our Screens Program as provided in this Section. The treasurer may utilize up to five percent of the 24 25 monies in the Louisiana Loggers Relief Fund and the Louisiana Save Our Screens 26 Fund for administration of the programs. Notwithstanding any provision of law to 27 the contrary, the treasurer may enter into consulting services, professional services, 28 and information and technology services contracts for the purpose of the 29 procurement of any goods or services necessary to implement and expedite the 30 distribution of funds as emergency procurements exempt from the provisions of the Louisiana Procurement Code and corresponding rules and regulations. The cost of 31
- 32 <u>such contracts shall be considered administrative expenses.</u>
 33 <u>B. Any business receiving funding from a program within the Louisiana</u>
 34 Main Street Recovery Program pursuant to this Section shall meet the following
- (1) Had a physical and active operation in Louisiana as of March 1, 2020.

- 1 (2) Had fifty or fewer full-time equivalent employees as of March 1, 2020. 2 (3) Filed Louisiana taxes for tax years 2019 and 2020. 3 (4) Experienced a revenue loss of ten percent or greater of gross revenue for 4 the period of January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020, as compared to the gross 5 revenue of the business during the same period in 2019. 6 (5) Is in good standing with the secretary of state. 7 (6) Does not exist for the purpose of advancing partisan political activity. 8 (7) Does not directly lobby federal or state officials. 9 (8) Does not derive income from passive investments without active 10 participation in business operations. C. Any grant award received pursuant to this Section combined with any 11 12 monies received pursuant to the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program as 13 provided in R.S. 39:100.44, United States Small Business Administration-Guaranty 14 Paycheck Protection Program loan, and United States Small Business Administration 15 Economic Injury Disaster Loan Emergency Advance shall not exceed the amount of 16 revenue loss experienced by the business during the period provided for in 17 Subsection (B)(4) of this Section. 18 Priority shall be given to businesses that previously submitted 19 applications to the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program as provided in R.S. 20 39:100.44 but whose applications were not considered due to exhaustion of monies in the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Fund. 21 22 E. The Louisiana Loggers Relief Program is hereby established as a 23 component of the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program. The program shall 24 provide grants to eligible timber harvesting and timber hauling businesses impacted 25 by COVID-19. Any grant received pursuant to this Subsection shall not exceed 26 twenty-five thousand dollars per business. In addition to the criteria provided in 27 Subsection B of this Section, a timber harvesting or timber hauling business shall 28 meet all of the following criteria to be eligible to receive a grant: 29 (1) Is assigned a North American Industry Classification System Code of 30 113310 or 484220. 31 (2) Is certified by the Louisiana Forestry Association as a master logger. 32 (3) Is not a subsidiary of a business with more than fifty full-time equivalent 33 employees, is not part of a larger business enterprise with more than fifty full-time 34 equivalent employees, and is not owned by a business with more than fifty full-time 35 equivalent employees. 36 F. The Louisiana Save Our Screens Program is hereby established as a 37 component of the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program. The program shall 38 provide grants to eligible movie theater businesses impacted by COVID-19. Any grant received pursuant to this Subsection shall not exceed ten thousand dollars per 39 40 movie screen located in Louisiana. Theatres with corporate ownership based outside 41 of Louisiana shall use funds received pursuant to this Subsection for Louisiana-based 42 screens and operations. In addition to the criteria provided in Subsection B of this 43 Section, a business shall meet all of the following criteria to be eligible to receive a 44 grant: 45 (1) Is a movie theater that has at least one permanent indoor auditorium for 46 viewing films for entertainment by the general public who attend by the purchase of 47 an individual ticket to view a specific non-adult-oriented film. 48 (2) Conducted regularly scheduled screenings in Louisiana in calendar year 49 2019. 50 (3) Is currently open and actively operating as of the effective date of this 51 Section. 52 (4) Was subject to limitations or restrictions as a result of Proclamation Number 25 JBE 2020 or any subsequent gubernatorial proclamations related to 53 54 COVID-19."

§100.52. Louisiana Water Infrastructure Fund

- A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the Louisiana Water Infrastructure Fund, hereinafter referred to in this Section as the "fund". The treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer three hundred million dollars from the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund into the Louisiana Water Infrastructure Fund.
- B. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the fund shall be deposited in and credited to the fund.
- C. Monies in the fund shall be used to provide grant funding for repairs, improvements, and consolidation of water systems and sewerage systems pursuant to the Louisiana Water Infrastructure Program as provided in R.S. 39:100.56.

§100.53. Granting Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities Fund

- A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the Granting Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities (GUMBO) Fund, hereinafter referred to as the "fund". The treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer ninety million dollars from the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund into the fund.
- B. All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the fund shall be deposited in and credited to the fund.
- C. Monies in the fund shall be used to provide grants to help fund broadband access in rural and disadvantaged areas pursuant to the provisions of the Granting Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities program established by law.

46 §100.54. Louisiana Loggers Relief Fund

1	A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the
2	Louisiana Loggers Relief Fund, hereinafter referred to in this Section as the "fund".
3	The treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer ten million dollars from
4	the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund into the fund. Monies in the fund shall be used to
5	provide economic support grants to eligible Louisiana timber harvesting and timber
6	hauling businesses in accordance with the provisions of the Louisiana Loggers Relief
7	Program as provided in R.S. 39:100.44.1.
8	B. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the
9	state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the fund shall be
10	deposited in and credited to the fund.
11	C. Any remaining balance in the fund on January 1, 2022, shall be
12	transferred to the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund.
13	§100.55. Louisiana Save Our Screens Fund
14	A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the
15	Louisiana Save Our Screens Fund, hereinafter referred to in this Section as the
16	"fund". The treasurer is hereby authorized to transfer four million five hundred
17	thousand dollars from the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund into the fund. Monies in the
18	fund shall be used to provide economic support grants to eligible movie theater
19	owners and operators in accordance with the Louisiana Save Our Screens Program
20	as provided in R.S. 39:100.44.1.
21	B. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the
22	state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the fund shall be
23	deposited in and credited to the fund.
24	C. Any remaining balance in the fund on January 1, 2022, shall be
25	transferred to the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund.
26	§100.56. Louisiana Water Infrastructure Program
27	A. As used in this Section, the following terms shall have the following
28	meanings:
29	(1) "Committee" shall mean the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget.
30	(2) "Office" shall mean the office of public health in the Louisiana
31	Department of Health.
32	(3) "Fund" shall mean the Louisiana Water Infrastructure Fund.
33	B. The Louisiana Water Infrastructure Program is hereby established to
34	provide grant funding for repairs, improvements, and consolidation of community
35	water systems. The office shall administer the program. The office shall establish
36	a review panel comprised of employees of the office, the office of community
37	development in the division of administration, the Department of Environmental
38	Quality, and the legislative auditor. The review panel shall review and rate
39	applications submitted by community water systems and local governing authorities
40	and submit recommendations for funding to the Joint Legislative Committee on the
41	Budget.
42	C. The office shall promulgate rules for the administration of the program.
43	The rules shall include application requirements, a timeline for application
44	submissions and approval, criteria for ratings, a process for prioritizing critical
45	infrastructure needs, and requirements for waivers of matching funds or decreased
46	match. The Administrative Procedure Act, R.S. 49:950 et seq., shall not apply to
47	rules promulgated pursuant to this Section. No later than ninety days after the
48	effective date of this Section, the office shall submit the rules to the committee for
49	review and approval. Any changes to the initial rules shall require approval by the
50	committee.
51	D. In addition to the rules provided for in Subsection C of this Section, the
52	office shall submit a proposed budget outlining administrative expenses for the
53	program to the committee for review and approval prior to implementing the
54	program.
55	E. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the office may enter
56	into consulting services, professional services, and information and technology

services contracts for the purpose of the procurement of any goods or services

1	necessary to implement and expedite the distribution of funds as emergency
2	procurements exempt from the provisions of the Louisiana Procurement Code and
3	corresponding rules and regulations. The cost of such contracts shall be considered
4	administrative expenses.
5	F. Each grant recipient shall be required to provide matching funds unless
6	the review panel recommends waiving the match requirement.
7	G. Upon committee approval of the rules, the office shall begin accepting
8	applications. The applications shall include the following, at a minimum:
9	(1) The amount of grant funding requested.
10	(2) The amount and proposed source of funding for the required match.
11	(3) Proposals for repairs, improvements, or consolidation with neighboring
12	systems.
13	(4) Proposals for ensuring the financial sustainability and compliance of the
14	systems, including proposals for increasing rates paid by users of the system based
15	on a fair assessment of the system to comparable systems.
16	H. The review panel's funding recommendations to the committee shall
17	include:
18	(1) Recommendations for utilization of existing resources including the
19	Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund, Clean Water State Revolving Fund, and
20	Community Water Enrichment and Other Improvements Fund.
21	(2) Certification that the local governing authority that operates the system
22	either utilized funding received pursuant to the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery
23	Fund of the American Rescue Act Plan of 2021 as the source of funding for the
24	required match or had legitimate cause that precluded the use of those funds for the
25	<u>match.</u>
26	I. Upon approval of any funding recommendations, the committee may
27	appropriate monies from the fund to the system or local governing authority that
28	operates the system.
29	J. No money shall be expended from the fund without approval of the
30	committee.
31	K. The provisions of R.S. 39:72.1(A) shall not apply to monies appropriated
32	from the fund pursuant to this Section."
