Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

BUDGETARY CONTROLS: (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to deficit avoidance procedures

1	A JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Proposing to amend Article VII, Section 10(F)(2)(a) and (b) of the Constitution of
3	Louisiana, relative to deficit avoidance; to increase the amount of allowable
4	reductions to certain funds when there is a projected deficit; to provide for
5	submission of the proposed amendment to the electors; and to provide for related
6	matters.
7	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
8	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state of
9	Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to
10	amend Article VII, Section 10(F)(2)(a) and (b) of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as
11	follows:
12	ARTICLE VII
13	§10. Expenditure of State Funds
14	Section 10.

16	(F) Projected Deficit.

18	(2)(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this constitution to the
19	contrary, adjustments to any constitutionally protected or mandated allocations or
20	appropriations, and transfer of monies associated with such adjustments, are

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1 authorized when state general fund allocations or appropriations have been reduced 2 in an aggregate amount equal to at least seven-tenths of one percent of the total of 3 such allocations and appropriations for a fiscal year. Such adjustments may shall not 4 exceed five twenty percent of the total appropriation or allocation from a fund for the fiscal year. For purposes of this Subsubparagraph, reductions to expenditures 5 6 required by Article VIII, Section 13(B) of this constitution shall not exceed one 7 percent and such reductions shall not be applicable to instructional activities included 8 within the meaning of instruction pursuant to the Minimum Foundation Program 9 formula. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this constitution to the contrary, 10 monies transferred as a result of such budget adjustments are deemed available for 11 appropriation and expenditure in the year of the transfer from one fund to another, 12 but in no event shall the aggregate amount of any transfers exceed the amount of the 13 deficit.

14 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this constitution to the contrary, 15 for the purposes of the budget estimate and enactment of the budget for the next 16 fiscal year, when the official forecast of recurring revenues for the next fiscal year 17 is at least one percent less than the official forecast for the current fiscal year, the 18 following procedure may be employed to avoid a budget deficit in the next fiscal 19 year. An amount not to exceed five twenty percent of the total appropriations or 20 allocations for the current fiscal year from any fund established by law or this 21 constitution shall be available for expenditure in the next fiscal year for a purpose 22 other than as specifically provided by law or this constitution. For the purposes of 23 this Subsubparagraph, an amount not to exceed one percent of the current fiscal year 24 appropriation for expenditures required by Article VIII, Section 13(B) of this 25 constitution shall be available for expenditures for other purposes in the next fiscal 26 year. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this constitution to the contrary, 27 monies made available as authorized under this Subsubparagraph may be transferred 28 to a fund for which revenues have been forecast to be less than the revenues in the 29 current fiscal year for such fund. Monies transferred as a result of the budget actions

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1	authorized by this Subsubparagraph are deemed available for appropriation and
2	expenditure, but in no event shall the aggregate amount of any such transfers exceed
3	the amount of the difference between the official forecast for the current fiscal year
4	and the next fiscal year.

6	Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted
7	to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on November 8,
8	2022.
9	Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at the election,
10	there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted
11	to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as
12	follows:
13	Do you support an amendment to increase the amount of allowable deficit
14	reductions to statutory dedications and constitutionally protected funds from
15	five percent to twenty percent? (Amends Article VII, Section 10(F)(2)(a) and
16	(b))

Abstract: Increases allowable reductions to statutory dedications and constitutionally protected funds from 5% to 20% when there is a projected budget deficit.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the governor to unilaterally reduce state general fund appropriations to avoid a projected budget deficit, provided the reductions are only to the executive branch and reductions for an agency do not exceed 3% of the agency's total appropriation.

<u>Present law</u> provides that once the governor reduces total state general fund appropriations by 7/10 of 1%, he can take the following actions with approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget (JLCB):

- (1) Reduce statutory dedications (including constitutional funds) by up to 5%.
- (2) Reduce an additional 5% of the total state general fund amount appropriated for the fiscal year.

(3) Reduce the MFP provided the reduction does not exceed 1% and does not apply to instructional activities.

<u>Proposed constitution</u> increases the allowable reduction to statutory dedications, including constitutional funds from 5% to 20% of the total appropriation or allocation from the fund for the fiscal year.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Nov. 8, 2022.

(Amends Article VII, \$10(F)(2)(a) and (b))

### Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Appropriations</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:
- 1. Remove changes to the deficit avoidance process.
- 2. Remove the cap on allowable deficit reductions to higher education and the La. Dept. of Health.
- 3. Remove the repeal of exemptions from deficit reductions for certain constitutional funds.
