- 8 "to provide for refusal to mandate COVID-19 vaccination; to provide relative to
- 9 business and professional licenses;"

## 10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

- On page 1, delete lines 8 through 16 in their entirety, and insert the following:
- 12 "§2800.28. COVID-19 vaccination mandates; limitation of liability; protection of
- business permits and professional licenses
- A. No natural or juridical person shall be liable for any civil damages, and no cause of action may be maintained against a natural or juridical person who, in the course of, through the performance of, or by a provision of the person's business operations, refuses to mandate a COVID-19 vaccination or immunization for any
- operations, refuses to mandate a COVID-19 vaccination or immunization for any employee or customer.
- B. No state, state agency, or political subdivision of the state shall refuse to permit, renew, or withhold a business license or professional license solely on the basis that the business has refused to mandate a COVID-19 vaccination or
- immunization for any employee or customer."
