| 2 | To designate September 2021 as Prostate Cancer Awareness Month in Louisiana. |
| 3 | WHEREAS, prostate cancer is the most frequently diagnosed cancer among men in |
| 4 | Louisiana and the second most frequently diagnosed in men worldwide; and |
| 5 | WHEREAS, during 2021, the American Cancer Society estimates there will be |
| 6 | 248,530 new cases of prostate cancer and 34,130 deaths from prostate cancer in the United |
| 7 | States; and |
| 8 | WHEREAS, one in eight men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer during his |
| 9 | lifetime; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, prostate cancer is rare in men younger than forty, but the chance of |
| 11 | having prostate cancer rises rapidly after age fifty and approximately sixty percent of cases |
| 12 | are found in men older than sixty-five; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, most prostate cancers occur in men without a family history of it, but |
| 14 | having a father or brother with prostate cancer more than doubles a man's risk of developing |
| 15 | this disease with the risk becoming much higher for men with several affected relatives; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, despite its frequency of diagnosis, if prostate cancer is detected in the |
| 17 | early stages, the survival rate is nearly one hundred percent; and |
| 18 | WHEREAS, prostate cancer can often be found early by testing for prostate-specific |

| 1 | antigen levels in a man's blood; and |

| 2 | WHEREAS, an annual blood test is recommended for men starting at age fifty and |
| 3 | at age forty-five for those with family members with prostate cancer; and |
| 4 | WHEREAS, men who have prostate cancer and are educated about the value of early |
| 5 | detection will be more likely to have the cancer detected when it is treatable; and |
| 6 | WHEREAS, National Prostate Health Month, also known as National Prostate |
| 7 | Cancer Awareness Month, is observed every September in North America by health experts, |
| 8 | health advocates, and individuals concerned with men's prostate health and prostate cancer. |
| 9 | THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana |
| 10 | does hereby designate September 2021 as Prostate Cancer Awareness Month in Louisiana. |
| 11 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the |
