AN ACT

To enact R.S. 4:3, relative to the playing or singing of the national anthem prior to certain athletic events; to provide for requirements; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 4:3 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§3. Playing or singing of the national anthem at certain athletic contests

No competitive athletic event may be held in a venue, the construction, operation, or maintenance of which is financed wholly or partially by the state or a political subdivision of the state, unless the event is preceded by the playing or singing of the national anthem.
