A RESOLUTION

To urge and request the First Judicial District Court of Louisiana to submit recommendations for redistricting the election sections of the court based upon the 2020 federal decennial census.

WHEREAS, following the release of the 2020 federal decennial census redistricting data, the legislature may redistrict the election districts established by law for courts in this state; and

WHEREAS, R.S. 13:477(1) divides the First Judicial District Court into three election sections; and

WHEREAS, in the exercise of its authority, the Senate seeks recommendations from the court regarding the redistricting of the election sections of the court based upon the 2020 federal decennial census.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the First Judicial District Court to submit recommendations for redistricting the election sections of the court based upon the 2020 federal census to the Senate no later than December 31, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be transmitted to the Chief Judge of the First Judicial District Court.
