McMath

Creates the Survivor Informed Task Force to study the link between trauma, abuse, and subsequent incarceration, including secondary survivors of domestic or intimate partner violence, and to report findings and make a report of findings and recommendations to the governor and the legislature by 1/15/22.

The task force is composed of the following members:

- (1) The author of this resolution, or his designee.
- (2) The governor, or his designee.
- (3) The president of the Senate, or his designee.
- (4) The speaker of the House of Representatives, or his designee.
- (5) The chief justice of the La. Supreme Court, or his designee.
- (6) The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, or his designee.
- (7) The president of the La. Sheriffs' Association, or his designee.
- (8) Two members of the La. District Attorneys Association, one of whom shall be a practicing victims assistance coordinator.
- (9) The executive director of the La. Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice, or his designee.
- (10) The executive director of Sexual Trauma Awareness and Response (STAR), or his designee.
- (11) The executive director of the La. Foundation Against Sexual Assault (LaFASA), or his designee.
- (12) The executive director of the La. Coalition Against Domestic Violence (LCADV), or his designee.
- (13) The executive director of Voice of The Experienced (VOTE), or his designee.
- (14) The executive director of La. Survivors for Reform (LSR), or his designee.
- (15) The executive director of Operation Restoration, or his designee.
- (16) A representative from the staff of the La. Public Defender Board.
- (17) A public defender appointed by the La. Public Defender Board.
- (18) A representative from Right on Crime.
