Existing law provides that an individual who is retired from service as a qualified law enforcement officer and who was commissioned by the agency or office from which he retired and is carrying the identification required by his office as a retired law enforcement officer, may carry a concealed firearm anywhere in the state, including any place open to the public.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that the retired law enforcement officer shall have identification which proves he is a retired law enforcement officer.

<u>New law</u> requires the head of the office or agency from which the individual has retired to issue identification required by the provisions of <u>existing law</u>.

Specifies that <u>new law</u> shall have retroactive and prospective application.

Effective August 1, 2021.
